Dear Cllr,

I am writing to you today regarding Scottish and Southern Electricity Network's (SSEN) East Coast 400kV Overhead line consultation.

You will of course be fully aware of the proposals to construct new overhead powerlines between Fiddes and Kintore, including a new substation at Fiddes.

I firmly believe that new energy infrastructure is required to meet our net zero ambitions and ensure our energy security. However, these infrastructure projects must be completed with the consent of local residents and that those responsible must engage with communities and consider their feedback.

Many residents have already contacted me to share their thoughts on the proposals, I am sure you have been contacted as well. With this in mind I am urging you to encourage affected residents in your ward to participate in SSEN's consultation.
